Beverly:



Dr. Robert Dickson, MD from Calgary wrote a letter to the AHS Medical Officers of Health and the City Councillors for Calgary and Lethbridge.

Subject: Important new science on water fluoridation

Greeting from Australia. I hope you have all wintered well in Alberta.

Dr. James Beck and I are gravely concerned. It appears that, as you are all very busy, much of the new science around fluoride and water fluoridation has escaped your purview, or that it has been otherwise neglected or marginalized. In an effort to assist you in keeping abreast of all the new science these days, and to assist in public education and policy formulation, I have appended important links below.

I would much appreciate if you can look carefully at these studies and get back to me with comments as soon as possible.

Anyone who chooses to ignore the plethora of new and mostly good science against water fluoridation will only be digging a deeper hole from which to extricate themselves when this poorly constructed and unscientific program is finally taken to its grave in the near future.

As Alan Greenspan stated in his recent book, it is a Herculean task for public officials to admit that they are wrong. May you have the strength of many!

Interesting Information

FLUORIDE & IQ: THE 43 STUDIES

As of February 2015, a total of 50 studies have investigated the relationship between fluoride and human intelligence, and a total of 33 studies have investigated the relationship fluoride and learning/memory in animals. Of these investigations, 43 of the 50 human studies have found that elevated fluoride exposure is associated with reduced IQ, while [31 of the 33 animal studies](#) have found that fluoride exposure impairs the learning and/or memory capacity of animals. The human studies, which are based on IQ examinations of over 11,000 children, provide compelling evidence that fluoride exposure during the early years of life can damage a child's developing brain...

Summary

When considering their consistency with numerous animal studies, it is very unlikely that the 43 human studies finding associations between fluoride and reduced IQ can *all* be a random fluke. The question today, therefore, is less *whether* fluoride reduces IQ, but at what dose, at what time, and how this dose and time varies based on an individual's nutritional status, health status, and exposure to other contaminants (e.g., aluminum, arsenic, lead, etc). Of particular concern is fluoride's effect on children born to women with [suboptimal iodine intake](#) during

the time of pregnancy, and/or fluoride's effects on infants and toddlers with suboptimal iodine intake themselves. According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control, approximately [12% of the U.S. population](#) has deficient exposure to iodine.
