Is it Safe for the Environment?

- Fluoride has been called "The most damaging environmental pollutant of the Cold War."
- Fluoride gases are **hazardous air pollutants** laced with heavy metals and radioactive contaminants, which by law, must be wet-scrubbed out of industry smokestacks.
- Industries cannot allow fluoride to escape into the environment because of the known adverse effects of destroying crops, killing livestock and poisoning humans. Yet if it is carefully metered into our water supply, that's deemed okay?
- In the words of Dr. J. William Hirzy (2000) Senior Chemist at the US EPA:
- "If this stuff (hydrofluorosilicic acid) gets out into the air, it's a pollutant; if it gets into the river, it's a pollutant; if it gets into the lake, it's a pollutant; but if it goes right straight into your drinking water system, it's not a pollutant. That's amazing."

Is it Economical?

- Lethbridge spends approximately \$100,000 per year on hydrofluorosilicic acid.
- 99% of fluoridated water is **not consumed** but used for washing cars, watering lawns, flushing toilets.
- That amounts to \$99,000 going down the drain, causing severe environmental pollution.

Is it Ethical?

- Fluoride is the **only substance added** to our water **to treat the person**, not the water.
- No doctor has the right to administer medication without the informed consent of his/her patient.
- Water fluoridation discriminates against Blacks, Hispanics and Indigenous peoples who are more susceptible to fluoride toxicity.
- Water fluoridation discriminates against mothers who bottle-feed. A baby fed formula mixed with Lethbridge tap water receives up to 400% of the safe dosage.
- Water fluoridation **discriminates against all the citizens of Lethbridge** who must pay to put it in, and pay to filter it out or buy bottled water. Does this make sense to you?!
- How can the poor afford expensive filtration or even bottled water? Isn't this grossly unfair?
