Fluoridation of the Lethbridge drinking water was one of the top three election issues a couple of weeks ago. Now, the word on the street is that "fluoride" is the **top** election issue.

Consequently, we're getting "adversity." Pro-fluoride groups are rising up and AHS is coming out with the big guns, writing letters to the candidates to persuade them fluoridation is safe and an advisable health measure.

This week, James Frey, as Senior Communications Officer for Alberta Health Services – South Zone, forwarded a personalized email to all of the candidates on behalf of AHS, promoting water fluoridation. Fluoride in our tap water: Medicine or Toxin? Tuesday, October 15 at 7:30 PM Community Room, CASA 230 8th Street South

Dr. James Beck, co-author with Dr. Paul Connett and Dr. H.S. Micklem, of the "The Case Against Fluoride: How Hazardous Waste Ended Up in Our Drinking Water and the Bad Science and Powerful Politics That Are Keeping It There" will be the main speaker. He will be accompanied by Dr. Robert Dickson, a Calgary family doctor who, like Dr. Beck, played a significant role in persuading the Calgary municipal government to remove hydrofluorosilicic acid from Calgary tap water in 2011.

On September 29 Dr. Gary W. Fong, President of the Alberta Dental Association and College, was invited by Dr. Anthony Hall to join Drs. Beck and Dickson by making a presentation at the upcoming Lethbridge event or to appoint a delegate to do so. Dr. Fong has indicated through an intermediary that he will not be taking part in the

forthcoming event nor will he appoint a delegate of the Alberta Dental Association and College to do so.

Are there any takers to debate the pro-fluoride side?

With or without the pro-fluoride side being represented, it will be an interesting evening. Plan to attend.
